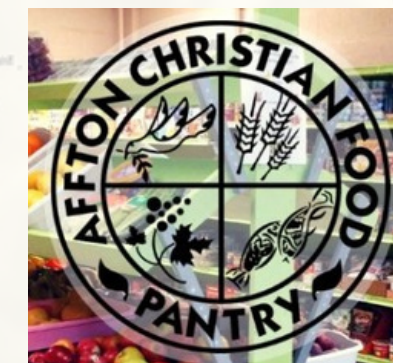

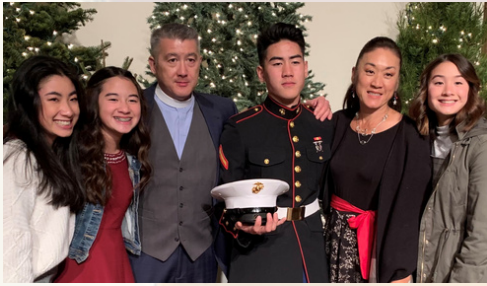
NORTH AMERICAN MISSIONS
